National & International Events

USA Swimming Board of Directors

The April meeting of the USA Swimming Board of Directors was held in Colorado Springs on April 28 & 29, 2006. Please read the Summer 2006 edition of the Central Zone Newsletter (www.centralzones.org) for the complete report from the this meeting.

Central Zone

- Meets: The Central Zone Directors are receiving bids for the 2008 Central Zone Championships through August 15.
- Meet Questionnaire: The Central Zone Championship Meet questionnaire was distributed at our April Board meeting. BOD members are reminded to complete this questionnaire prior to the Monday, June 19, to turn in to Arlene at the BOD meeting. Another copy of this form is attached for the convenience of BOD members.

2007 USA Swimming National Championships and Junior National Championships

- Arlene has continued to negotiate with local hotels for these events and conducted site visits at many properties. Hotels on the northside have been solicited for additional rooms. We are nearing 1000 rooms.
- Judy Thomas, ICVA Director of Special Events, has been assigned as our event coordinator. Arlene continues to meet with Judy in planning the event.
- Arlene met with the board of directors of Carmel Swim Club in May to discuss their potentially co-hosting of the Junior National Championships. She is awaiting their reply.
- Arlene met again with Peggy Swalls, Administration Vice President at the Indianapolis Motor Speedway. Peggy is arranging a meeting with various department heads at the Speedway to explore options for our guests in 2007.
- Julie and Arlene are participating in a conference call with Dean Ekeren and Matt Farrell at USA Swimming on June 15 to explore partnership opportunities for Indiana Swimming and USA Swimming in the promotion of the 2007 events.
- The first meeting of the Event Coordinators (Julie & Arlene) and Meet Coordinators (club representatives) will take place by mid-July.
- Arlene has received approval from USA Swimming to have a "booth" in Irvine this summer to distribute/explain hotel information and provide other city information. The ICVA is assisting in organizing this information.

LSC Development - National Events: Solicitation & Coordination

- Arlene is continuing talks with USA Swimming regarding the potential to host the 2007 Open Water Championships. The dates and site are still being investigated.
- Beginning in December of 2007, USA Swimming will be sponsoring a Short Course National Championship. Arlene has sent an inquiry to USA Swimming regarding the selection of sites for this event.

IU Natatorium "Preserve the Memories" Campaign

- The committee membership has been expanded. The following swimming enthusiasts and community members compose the organizing committee: Mel Goldstein (USMS), Wayne Burrow (NCAA), Tim Hewitt (Veolia), Mike Dilts (Shiel Sexton), Scott Davison (One America – formerly AUL), Pat O'Connor (City Securities), Adolph & Joyce Keifer, Julie McKenney and Matt Reisweg (IU Natatorium), Lynn Kinstler, Tony Young, and Arlene McDonald (Indiana Swimming). Pat, Scott, and Tim, with input from Julie and Arlene, are putting constructing a business plan for the Natatorium to be presented to University officials within the next month.
- Mel, Pat, Tim, Julie, and Arlene met with IUPUI Vice-Chancellors and representatives of the IU Foundation on June 14 to discuss the components and direction of the campaign. Arlene will provide more information regarding this meeting at the Monday BOD meeting.

GENERAL

From April 17 to present my focus as Sport Development Director has revolved around such Special Events as Swimposium coordinator, IMX Incentive Program and Camps. Office duties include: coordination of site selection meeting, updating Times Database, Blast e-mails, sanctions and scheduling are ongoing. Priority has been given to increased travel and club transitional periods. Special Projects include my participation on a committee to develop a High School Hall of Fame and induction banquet, sitting in on the USA Swimming Club Development staff, Age Group Committee Planning meetings via conference call and assisting in coordinating the camps program.

SPECIAL EVENTS/PROJECTS

SWIMPOSIUM

We had 49 Coaches and 126 athletes attend the Swimposium on April 22 at Brownsburg High School. Milt Nelms (2005 Swimposium Keynote speaker) and Alex Nikitin (Creator of Race Analysis) were guest presenters. Milt spent the Friday night prior to the Swimposium working with the Swim Indy coaches and athletes.

As Milt and Alex presented to the athletes and coaches, I conducted two presentations to the athletes on understanding Race Analysis.

A special guest presenter was Olympic Gold Medallist from Australia; Shane Gould who worked with the athletes in and out of the water as well as doing autograph sessions.

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Milt, Alex, Shane and I all debriefed after the Swimposium and created follow-up materials on Race Analysis that will be available on the Indiana Swimming Website.

Many thanks to our BOD members, Ron Jones, the Swim Indy parents, coaches and athletes for their efforts in making this years Swimposium as success.

RACE ANALYSIS

Alex Nikitin assisted in the editing of race data for the 06 SCY Senior and SAG State meets. Some of the results were not recoverable due to data collection errors. Both Alex Nikitin (Parametrix) and Milt Nelms (Swimposium Speaker) have created practical ideas and recommendations on how to utilize the Race Analysis in training. Along with this information, a presentation on understanding Race Analysis and the results from the Senior State and SAG meets will be posted on the ISI website.

CLUB VISITS

Many of the club visits in April and May have been Strategic Thinking and planning meetings. This is a multi-step process which assists clubs in all areas of developing mission & vision statements to developing strategies to achieve goals. These meetings have been informative both to the club and to myself in understanding the goals and needs of our clubs.

The majority of my time in the months of April and May have been designated to many of our club's transitional periods.

I continue to promote the SDD position though blast e-mails, phone calls, club and meet visits. I meet with coaches on a regular basis as a sounding board and now assisting with staff retreats. Also assist coaches with job searches.

Assisting clubs with staff job hiring, work improvement programs, vision & mission goals and club progressions. All communications are ongoing and build to numerous club visits.

CAMPS

I have attended or will be attending all of our Indiana Swimming camp. I work with each staff in assisting with, camp communication, registration, promotion and setting up conference calls for staff organization. Post Camp duties include, finalizing all paperwork for USA Swimming "Catch the Spirit" camp reimbursement. The Catch the Spirit South Camp and Age Group Elite Camp have both conducted conference calls with staff to better devise staff responsibilities, coordinate all efforts and answer questions. I communicate with the Age Group Chair from Illinois Swimming to combined efforts with the LSC's for the Age Group Elite camp this summer.

Camp numbers were up for the One Day Catch the Spirit Camps and low for the Chick Newell Senior Memorial Day Camp. I conduct parent education meetings at each of these camps.

OPEN WATER

The rowing course at Eagle Creek belongs to the Indianapolis Rowing Club and will be staying in Indianapolis.

LSC / ZONE SPONSORSHIPS

I am still in contact with SPEEDO, TYR and FINIS to gather information on an LSC and/or Zone Sponsorship for Indiana Swimming. TYR is now more interested in negotiating an LSC Sponsorship package. More information should be available at the BOD meeting. Daktronics has sent a \$500 sponsorship from the Great Lakes Region and matching funds each year from their Indiana Southern Region.

This summer I will be attending at least one-two meets per weekend unless there is a camp or conflict with a club visit.

my apologies again for missing the May reporting deadline. The office was having email issues and we didn't receive any emails from insightbb.com addresses. Tina is an insightbb.com customer and we missed her reminders. By the time the reports were sent, those issues were corrected and we did receive the reports.

REGISTRATION / TIMES UPLOADS: The response to our pre-meet registration reconciliations has been tremendous! We're still working out some communication kinks, but overall, it's helped in uploading the results into SWIMS. There will still

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be many hours dedicated to getting all of the times into the national database, it just won't all be at the end of the season when we are cleaning out the holding tank.

TECHNOLOGY: The office has upgraded the copier in the office from the 19th century model to one from the 21st century! Thanks to board member Scott Ingram for his sales job on our new HPS model. Our old copier was a “donated” ancient model from HPS. The owner had donated various older models for the past 18 years at no cost to us, so that generosity is duly noted and appreciated. Next up on the upgrades will be to purchase a server and upgrade some programs within that new networking structure. Plans to integrate that will be by the end of summer. Additionally, I have initially met with a website designer on our needs/wants for a fresher/cleaner look. The designer is to contact me by the end of this month with options to select. Our entire technology upgrades should be well within the \$20,000 budget approved in October out of our money market funds (NOT any operating budget funds).

Other April/May/June projects included: hosted the championship coordination meeting, input on a revised format to the LSC championship entry letters, attended a “Preserving the Memories” task force/committee meeting, assisted with registration/check-in at the April Swimposium, brainstormed with Arlene McDonald and Tony Young on the House of Delegates meeting and the “Year of the Club” Summit (the two of them did most of the planning), aided and will continue to offer support for the Central Zone LOC in preparation for the August event, and convention budget estimates.

Upcoming (not mentioned above):

- Post the state championship letters on the website (should be done by the time most of you read this).
- Receive link for the online entry process to add to the championship page. I have already submitted information to volunteer Bob Hartley last month who actually hosts those on the WTSC site. I believe he's researching our website domain server company and their capabilities for the protocol he uses for that dynamic site.
- Receive championship team awards from supplier.
- Attend the Open Water Champs, Senior & Age Group Champs
- Aid Team Manager Emily Kowalski in the processing of entries for Team Indiana participants.
- Attend the Central Zone champs
- Assisting Lucy Duncan with the financials for the upcoming budget process.
- Convention registrations and hotel reservations
- Attend a few concerts this summer and hopefully get to the beach with family (anyone reading?)

SCHEDULING:

It was brought to our attention that in 2008, Easter falls near what seems like “traditional” Age Group Championship dates. However, the IHSAA Boys Finals are actually scheduled for 2/22-23. Therefore, our DIVISIONALS will be the following weekend, 2/29-March 2; Senior State 3/7-9 and Age Group State 3/14-16. This will be posted on the website at the end of the summer season when I remove the 2006 important dates from the schedule page.

PROMOTION / MARKETING / SPONSORSHIPS / FUNDRAISING

1. Priority: PROMOTION: Update the format/look of the website by end of summer.
 - a. Meet with a Front Page workshop instructor on our wishes/needs. (Completed 5/16/2006)
 - b. Request for Proposal on design solicited (to be submitted by designer by end of June)
 - c. Integrate new look/same content for site (projected completion – end of summer season)

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2. Priority: **MARKETING/SPONSORSHIP**: ISI Board policy on advertising/marketing partnerships
 - a. Tony has been working with Daktronics on a sponsorship for IN Swimming which in return would include a link on the IN Swimming website and presence at all state meets. Details are still being worked out.
 - b. At the April 2006 Board meeting, a motion was made by Mark Hesse; seconded by Brian Hindson that we set a value of \$250 for a link on the website and an additional \$250 for state meet presence (table on concourse) for a 1 year contract. A friendly amendment was made by Scott Ingram to change the dollar amounts to \$500 each and that the link be on the front page of the website (not preferred partners section). This friendly amendment passed, as did the amended motion.
 - c. There was a recommendation to put together a task force to study the policy of sponsorships
We need to meet via conference call (maybe with others) on addressing this still not so black and white issue, so that we are all clear on what a potential marketing partner/sponsor will receive for their money.
Plans for a conference call before the July 10th so that we can get something finalized by the August Board meeting and we're set for future seasons?

3. Priority: **FUNDRAISING** - Licensed logo apparel contract
 - a. Meet with Circle City Swimwear on current agreement and proposal to renew "licensing use of logo" contract.
 - b. Comments/suggestions welcome. We've already gone down the road of script cards, zoo books, and others. Hosting meets (national level) seem to be our strongpoint and success means to make money.

CONVENTION 2006 dates were discussed. 14 board members expressed interest in attending the Detroit convention. They were asked to stay after the meeting to discuss.

2010 CALENDAR

The NCAA and the University of Indianapolis would like to bring Division 2 nationals back to the IU Natatorium. Their proposed weekend is March 7-13 (Sunday-Saturday). Our SR champs are currently scheduled for March 12-14. We gave up our Natatorium dates for 2006 (back in 2004) for this same situation.

MOTION: To allow the NCAA/UIndy to have the Natatorium on our already reserved weekend and solicit other hosts/facilities for this March 2010 date. **PASSED.**

REGISTRATION FINE PROCESS

USA Swimming rule 302.4: False Registration – A host LSC may impose a fine of up to \$100 per event against a member coach or a member club submitting a meet entry which indicates a swimmer is registered with USA Swimming when that swimmer or the listed club is not properly registered. The host LSC will be entitled to any fines imposed.

MOTION: Effective Fall 2006-07, assess fines to member clubs who violate this rule above with a \$100 per SWIMMER per MEET violation. This fine would be assessed if registration AND payment are not received within 2 weeks AFTER the meet. **PASSED.**

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Added MOTION: If the club does not pay their fines by the next registration year, their club charter will not be renewed.

Supporting information: Starting with the 2006 summer season, with the help of Michele DeLuna, we have been running PRE-MEET registration reconciliations for all INVITES. Host are reminded to send their backups once the meet deadline has passed (sanction checklist mandates that all invites list their deadlines as 2 weeks prior to the meet). Most are complying with this requirement. An email is sent to “offending” clubs who have entered this meet and registrations are not current. Instructions have been to e-file the batch report by at least the start of the meet and that money needs to arrive within the week after the meet. ANOTHER recon is run from the backup AFTER the meet and another set of emails goes out to offending clubs. Another 5-7 business days pass before we load the results into SWIMS / times. In summary, clubs entering invites have up to almost 3 weeks to register/pay for their swimmers. We are running POST meet recons on duals, etc, but they are given the same 5-7 business days as well before we load the results. Michele will generate a sampling of clubs who are unable to get their registrations in and therefore, we would assess fines. That report, based on the estimated 25-30 sanctions that have been swum since May 1, will be available at Monday’s meeting.

SPONSORS

There was discussion on who has the approval to negotiate sponsorship deals. Clubs and state hosts negotiate their own deals. State hosts can do just about anything but sell the rights of the title of the meet.

MOTION: Empower Tony to negotiate potential sponsorship deals. The values and numbers proposed need to be approved by the current General Chair and the current Finance Vice-Chair before any deals are signed. Tony will have approval to sign the deal after approval. The minimum length of a deal will be 3 years, with a maximum of 5 years. PASSED. This will be added to Tony’s job description/letter of agreement.
